

# HOST FAMILY INFORMATION FORM

We are in need of host families to house about 24 of the Donetsk dancers. We like to place at least two dancers per family. They will arrive in Lancaster the Wednesday before the performance and leave Saturday after the performances. You would need to pick the dancers up at Lancaster Mennonite Fine Arts Center in the evening. They could arrive anytime between 4:00 pm and 11:00 pm. They will land in the United States that day and we would keep you updated on how close they are to Lancaster. If you are unable to pick them up, we may be able to bring them to your home. You would be expected to transport the dancers to and from rehearsal, performances and provide meals.

Here are some suggestions on what they like to eat:

Seafood, fish, tuna fish, shish kabobs, potatoes (mashed, baked, potato salad, etc.), love mayonnaise on everything, coffee, hot tea, broccoli salad, chicken, salad and beef. For breakfast the woman like yogurt, juice, fruit, toast and oatmeal. The men like eggs and sausage. They do like cheesecake and sweets, but won't eat a lot of it. They will not eat turkey, pork (except sausage and bacon) or coleslaw.

Hosting dancers is an excellent way to get to know the Donetsk dancers and to learn about their culture and way of life.
